POST-MARCH BREAK CHANGES TO COVID RESTRICTIONS

FACE MASKS - INDOORS



Effective March 21, the mask mandate for schools and public places across the province was lifted. Under current federal mandates, masking remains mandatory at all times in public spaces for 14-days upon return from international travel.

Out of an abundance of caution and recognizing that our community has a high level of travel over the March Break, Trafalgar Castle School will continue its mandatory-masking policy for all students and staff through until Thursday, April 14. This policy will be reviewed at that time. Masking will not be required outdoors, during co-curricular sport or while dining.

FACE MASKS - OUTDOORS

Masks are **no longer required** for students, teachers or staff when **outdoors**.

FACE MASKS - INDOOR SPORTS & GYM CLASS

Masks are **now optional** for students during **indoor sports or gym class** when actively participating. **Masks should be worn when players are not participating, on the bench or watching play.**



MORNING DROP OFF

Drop off time is from 7:45 to 8 a.m.

Grade 4, 5, 6 enter through the Lions' Doors.

Grades 7 and 8 enter through the Tower Doors **OR** through the Kamcke Doors.

Grades 9 and 10 enter through the Kamcke Doors.

Grades 11 & 12 enter through the Tower Doors.

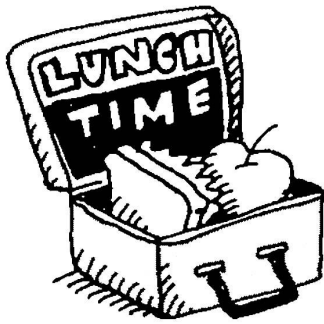


REACH APP & MORNING SCREENING

Students must complete the screening questionnaire every day before entering the building.

Screening staff will no longer be placed at the doors.

Student fobs will be activated between 7:40 and 8 a.m. for morning entry. [Students may **not** leave campus over the lunch hour.] Fobs will be released to students upon their return after March break..



LUNCH TIME

We will see a return to the Dining Hall for all students! Lunch will be served in the Dining Hall for all students at two different times.

Grade 4, 5, 6, 9, and 10 - 11:10 a.m. to 11:35 a.m.

Grade 7,8, 11 and 12 - 11:45 a.m. to 12:10 p.m.

The outdoor time during the lunch hour will remain for all students.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC

Masks are **no longer required** when playing Instrumental music.

In-person band practices **may resume**.



CO-CURRICULARS & CLUBS

Co-curriculars may now take place **in person**, although some clubs may elect to continue online for convenience.

Dragon's Den will return to in-person sessions held in the Project Room Monday through Thursdays.

After school co-curricular activities begin after 3:30 p.m.

Grades 4 through 12 may meet in person.



AFTER SCHOOL

Students in grades 7 through 12 are **no longer assigned to after-school locations by grade.**

Students are still required to be in the Loggia, the Common Room or the Project Room after school.

Grades 4, 5, 6 remaining after 3:30 p.m. must attend after-school care.



VISITORS TO THE SCHOOL

Visitors are welcome to the School on an **appointment-only basis**. All visitors must be fully vaccinated and present their proof of vaccination to reception and sign in and out.



SPECTATORS DURING GAMES

All spectators are invited to watch outdoor games.

Fully vaccinated spectators are invited to watch indoor games.

Spectators are expected to self-screen at the Gym door.

Masks will be required when inside the gym.

Maximum indoor capacity guidelines will be in place.



RETURN OF INTER-SCHOOL SPORTS

We are resuming full participation in CISAA interschool sports.

This will include Grades 4 to 6 with spring soccer.

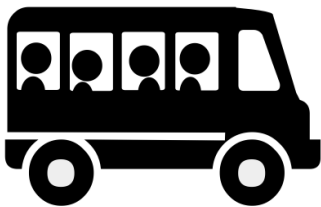
CISAA requires all participants to be fully vaccinated.
